

Did you contribute to the Millennium Fund?

The Year 2000 began a new millennium and Troop 31 marked the occasion by raising funds in honor of those Scouts who joined the Troop that year. The goal at the time was to do something special with the money -- ideas ranged from building a cabin to buying land to investing the funds for the future of Troop 31. Many families and friends of Troop 31 donated to what became known as the "Millennium Fund" and the total amount raised was \$875.

Fast forward 16 years...several of those Class of 2000 Scouts became Eagles, as have many after them, and the \$875 balance in our Millennium Fund still exists, waiting to be used for a good cause. This note is being published to notify donors to the Fund of the Troop's plans for the money and to give those donors an opportunity to share their thoughts.

Last spring, Troop 31 agreed to commit \$5,000 to constructing a new pavilion at the Rhodes campsite at Seven Mountains. The pavilion was constructed just in time for us to enjoy it during summer camp in July. And now we are in the process of paying down that financial commitment. The Troop Committee would like to devote the \$875 of the Millennium Fund toward this pavilion, but wants to be sure that donors to the Fund approve.
